This College was established in the year 1945 with a iiiodest strength of 80 students, the institution has grown leaps and bound under the able supervision of TTD management and presently offering under graduate courses in 21 disciplines and PG studies in 2 disciplines with an enrollment of about 2543 students. The institution has excellent hostel facilities and is hosting 1920 students in its four blocks of hostels. Most of the students of the institution are drawn from villages of Rayalaseema districts and belong to weaker sections. TTD Management has been magnanimous in providing free food for all the eligible students. The institution has excellent infrastructural facilities including well equipped laboratories for all Science Departments and a full fledged Computerised Laboratories for English and Commerce Departments apart from a very good Library with sufficient number of class rooms.

The institution boasts of a well-equipped Physical Education Department with excellent games facilities both for out door as well as indoor games. It also has a modem gymnasium.

NAAC ACCREDITATION,,

The institute has well qualified Teaching Faculty and also industrious Non-Teaching staff apart from excellent infra structural fecilities. Based on these credentials the college is assessed and accredited by UGC-NAAC with 'A' Grade in the year 2006.

COURSES OFFERED

The College is offering conventional UG Courses of B.A., B.Com, and B.Sc. In addition to this, self supporting restructured vocational courses such as Computer Science, Electronics, Dairy Science, Microbiology and Bio-technology are being offered keeping in view of the demand from student community.

PG Courses such as M.Sc. Organic Chemistry **and M. COITI** (F.M) (Financial Management) are introduced from the academic year 2008-2009 with an intake of 24 students in each subject. After completing PG Courses in our TTD institutions many students pursuing Ph.D Post Doctrol and research activities in well known universities of USA, UK, South Korea, other countries.

HOSTELS

However keeping in view of the large demand front student community who mail from rural places and with an intension to provide free food for' students coming from Below Poverty Line families, the college administration was forced to provide accommodation for about 1920 students which is much above the available capacity. The munificent TTD management is kind enough to provide additional hostel block in addition to expansion of hostel buildings.

LIBRARY

The College has an excellent book collection in its Library with over 1 lakh volumes of books. I hereby request the Devasthanams Educational Officer to take initiative in appointing Librarian and Assistant Librarian for good upkeep of the Library.

LABORATORIES

The institute is considered as the best among the colleges in Rayalaseema region on infrastructural facilities with well-equipped laboratories for each of the science subjects apart from English Language Laboratory and Commerce (Laboratory).

SECURITY:

The institution which is located in 36 acres of land with a huge college building and four blocks of hostels, sprawling play grounds and gymnasium, do not have adequate security system and very recently requested Executive Officer, TTD's, to provide adequate security for bringing in required discipline and safety in the institution and in all aspects. The Security and Physical Education Departments taking utmost care in solving the problems and giving right solutions to the physically handicapped and visually handicapped students for their overall developments.

CONTRACT LECTURERS:

At present the college has 50 lecturers working on contract mode and in order to get quality of education there is a need of regularizing the services of all those eligible teachers while making direct recruitment for the remaining vacancies. As requested by the Principal and HOD's, the Contract Lectures were appointed on the First day of the Reopening of college, from the Academic year 2018-19. In this regard I thank TTD Management for their initiation to strengthen the college academically.
