Established in the year 1945 with a modest strength of 80 students, the institution has grown leaps and bound under the able supervision of TTD management and presently offering under graduate courses in 21 disciplines and PG studies in 2 disciplines with an enrollment of about 2805 students. The institution has an excellent hostel and hosts 1703 students in its three blocks of hostels. Most of the students of the institution are drawn from villages of Rayalaseema districts and belong to weaker sections. TTD Management is magnanimous to provide free food for all the eligible students. The institution has an excellent infrastructure including well equipped laboratories, a full-fledged English Language Laboratory as well as Commerce and Computers laboratory apart from a very good Library with sufficient number of class rooms.

The institution boasts of a well-equipped Physical Education Department with excellent games facilities both for indoor and outdoor games. It also has a modern gymnasium.

#### NAAC ACCREDITATION

The institute has a well qualified Teaching Faculty and also industrious Non-Teaching staff apart from excellent infra structural fecilities. Based on these credentials the college is assessed and accredited by UGC-NAAC with 'A' Grade in the year 2006.

# **COURSES OFFERED**

The College offers conventional UG Courses of B.A., B.Com, and B.Sc. In addition to this, self supporting restructured vocational courses such as Computer Science, Electronics, Dairy Science, Micro Biology and Bio Technology are being offered by keeping in view of the demand from student community.

PG Courses such as M.Sc. Organic Chemistry and M.Com (F.M) (Financial Management) are introduced from the academic year 2008-2009 with an intake of 30 students in each subject. After completing PG Courses in our TTD institutions many students are pursuing Ph.D, Post Doctrol and research activities in well known universities of the USA, the UK, South Korea and other countries.

# **HOSTELS**

The institute has three blocks of Hostels with a capacity of about 2073 students. However keeping in view of the large demand from student community who hail from rural places and with an intension to provide free food for students coming from BPL families, the college administration was forced to provide accommodation for about 2073 students which is much above the available capacity. The TTD management is kind enough to provide additional hostel block in addition to expansion of hostel buildings and also provided the latest kitchen with steam generation plant to cook simultaneously for 2500 students.

#### **LIBRARY**

The College has an excellent book collection in its Library with 89,000 volumes of books. I hereby request the Devasthanams Educational Officer to take initiative step in appointing Librarian and Assistant Librarian for keeping the Library in good condition.

- 1. To improve the existing Library, TTD management has taken initiative step for modernising and digitalising the Library.
- 2. Mitra Jyothi, Braille Press provided Academic Books, as well as competitive books in Braille lipi for visually challenged students. The Department of Telugu played a pivotal role to setup Braille library in July 2019 with the support of Sri.Umamaheswara Rao and Bali Reddy the old students of this college.
- 3. A separate Cell for Competitive Books is provided in the Library for Students.

- 4. A separate Cell is accommodated for Girl Students to avoid some kind of disturbances.
- 5. Apart from all kinds of News Papers more than 30 kinds of Magazines in three Languages are provided for the benefit of students

#### **LABORATORIES**

The institute is the best among the colleges in Rayalaseema region for its infrastructural facilities with well-equipped laboratories for all science subjects, English Language Laboratory and Commerce Laboratory.

In view of improving the existing Laboratories the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams through Department of Education & Vidhyadhana Trust proposed for Modernization & Improving towards Digitalization facility within a short period that may be during the Year 2019-20.

# **MUSEUMS**

Two well established museums are available in the college for Dept of Botany and Zoology with the support of our benevolent TTD management. Rare and endangered plant and animal species are preserved in the museums. Rare fossils of some plant species are also available in the Botany Museums. I request the TTD management to appoint Museum keepers to maintain the above museums.

# **SECURITY:**

The institution which is in 36 acres of land with a huge college building and four blocks of hostels, sprawling play grounds and gymnasium, do not have adequate security system and very recently requested Executive Officer, TTD's, to provide adequate security for bringing in required discipline and safety in the institution and in all aspects. The Security and Physical Education Departments take utmost care in solving the problems and give right solutions to the physically challenged and visually challenged students for their overall developments.
