This college was Established in the year 1945 with a modest strength of 80 students, the institution has grown leaps and bound under the able supervision of TTD management and presently offers under graduate courses in 22 disciplines with an enrollment of about 3057 students. The institution has an excellent hostel and hosts 2000 students in its three blocks. Most of the students of the institution are hailed from villages of Rayalaseema districts and belong to financial weaker sections. TTD Management is magnanimous to provide free food for all the eligible students in the hostel. The institution has an excellent infrastructure which including well equipped laboratories, a full-fledged English Language Laboratory as well as Commerce and Computers laboratory apart from a very good Library with sufficient number of class rooms.

The institution boasts of a well-equipped Physical Education Department with excellent facilities both for indoor and outdoor games. It also has a modern gymnasium.

NAAC ACCREDITATION

The institute has a well-qualified teaching faculty and also industrious non-teaching staff apart from excellent infrastructural facilities. Based on these credentials the college was assessed and accredited with 'A' in the year 2006.

COURSES OFFERED

The College offers conventional UG Courses B.A., B.Com, and B.Sc. In these courses, self-supporting restructured vocational groups such as Computer Science, Electronics, Dairy Science, Micro Biology and Bio-Technology are being offered on demand from student community.

HOSTEL

Hostel administration consists of the warden, 3 Deputy Wardens, Manager and 35 male staff. Warden Dr. R. Ravi Kumar, Lecturer in Physics and three (3) Deputy Wardens namely 1.Sri.G.Venkateswarlu 2.Dr. M. Prasada Rao. The Hostel staff contains 36 regular staff members and 32 outsourcing workers.

The institute has three blocks of Hostels with a capacity of 2150 students. However in view of the large demand from student community who hail from rural background and with an intension to provide free food to students from BPL families, the college administration is forced to provide accommodation for 2000 students which is much above the available capacity. The TTD management is kind enough to provide additional hostel block in addition to existing hostel buildings and also provided the latest kitchen with steam generation plant.

LIBRARY

Three Museums are available in the college for Dept. of Botany, Zoology and History with the support of our benevolent TTD management. Rare and endangered

animal species are preserved in the Zoology Museum. Rare fossils of some plant species are also available in the Botany Museums.

SECURITY:

The institution which is in 50 acres of land with a huge college building and three blocks of hostels, sprawling playgrounds and gymnasium, do not have adequate security system. We have recently requested the Executive Officer, TTDs, to provide adequate security for bringing in required discipline and safety in the institution. The Security and Physical Education Departments take utmost care in solving the problems and give right solutions to the physically challenged and visually challenged students for their overall developments.
